We will institute a “one-time” opportunity sale available through July 31, 2009 that will provide discounted membership opportunity across the various membership classes.

Golf and Invitational Golf: \$16,000 paid \$6,000 upon application, \$5,000 on the first and second annual anniversary of membership

Sports and Invitational Sports: \$6,000 paid \$3,000 upon application and \$3,000 in the form of an interest free note which the club will waive if the member is in good standing on the second year anniversary of membership

Junior Legacy: \$16,000 paid in equal annual installments, the number of which will be equal to the number of years between the age of the applicant at membership application and the applicant's 35th birthday. Maximum 5 equal installments and a minimum of 3 equal installments. By way of example, an applicant is 31 years as of application. The applicant would pay 4 equal installments of \$4,000 beginning with the application and continuing on each anniversary date thereafter until paid in full.

Corporate: \$20,000 paid at application

Corporate Associate: \$1,500 paid at application plus \$1,500 interest free note for the first associate under the corporate membership and \$1,500 paid at application plus \$1,000 interest free note for each associate thereafter. The interest free note will be waived if the corporate associate is in good standing on the second anniversary of membership.

Swim & Tennis: \$1,000 paid at application; \$1,500 in the form of a note waived per above

Clubhouse: \$100 paid at application
