2012 Board Elections

2011 Election of Board Members for 2012 term - Call for Nominations by October 26, 2011

Per Lake Forest Country Club (LFCC) By-Laws (October 1993) three Board members will be elected to replace three expiring-term Board members. Each elected director will serve for a 3 year term.

At least 35 days prior to the annual meeting the slate of eligible Club members selected to stand for election are finalized by one of the two methods that follow:

- Board appointed Nominating Committee will receive nominations through
- o Self nomination from a qualified Club member or

Nomination of qualified Club member by another eligible Club member.

Once nominations are received, Nominating Committee will review per by-laws and through a majority vote present their recommendation for a slate of candidates.

A Membership Petition that is signed by 10 percent of qualified members who are not appointed to Nominating Committee or currently serving on the Board of Directors that presents a qualified Club member.

The Nominating Committee selected for 2011 will serve for 1 year (September 2011 – August 2012).

The 2012 Nominating Committee:

- Ron Story

A ballot of candidates will be presented to Club membership for their vote 35 days prior to the Annual Meeting of membership. Members may submit their vote by

- 1) US Postal Service or internal mail to LFCC – attention of Nominating Committee;
- 2) Proxy or;
- 3) An in-person vote at Annual meeting.

A majority of participation by Club membership will constitute a valid election.

No matter the method of submission of your vote the Club By-Laws require one vote per membership with membership number listed on ballot. While there is only one vote per membership, you may select one, two, or three candidates to receive your one vote (your choice of one candidate does not provide a cumulative effect for that one candidate).

Your selection(s) receives a weighted calculation based on membership type. Each candidate that receives a qualified member's vote will obtain the following weights:

- Golf, Junior Golf and Corporate Designee memberships – each vote is multiplied by 4.
- Sports Golf and Junior Sports Golf memberships – each vote is multiplied by 3.
- Swim and Tennis memberships – each vote is multiplied by 2.
- Clubhouse/Social memberships – each vote is multiplied by 1.

Questions on 2011 Board of Directors' election for 3 year term commencing in 2012 may be submitted to the Board/ Nominating Committee through Club Manager Jeff Campione.

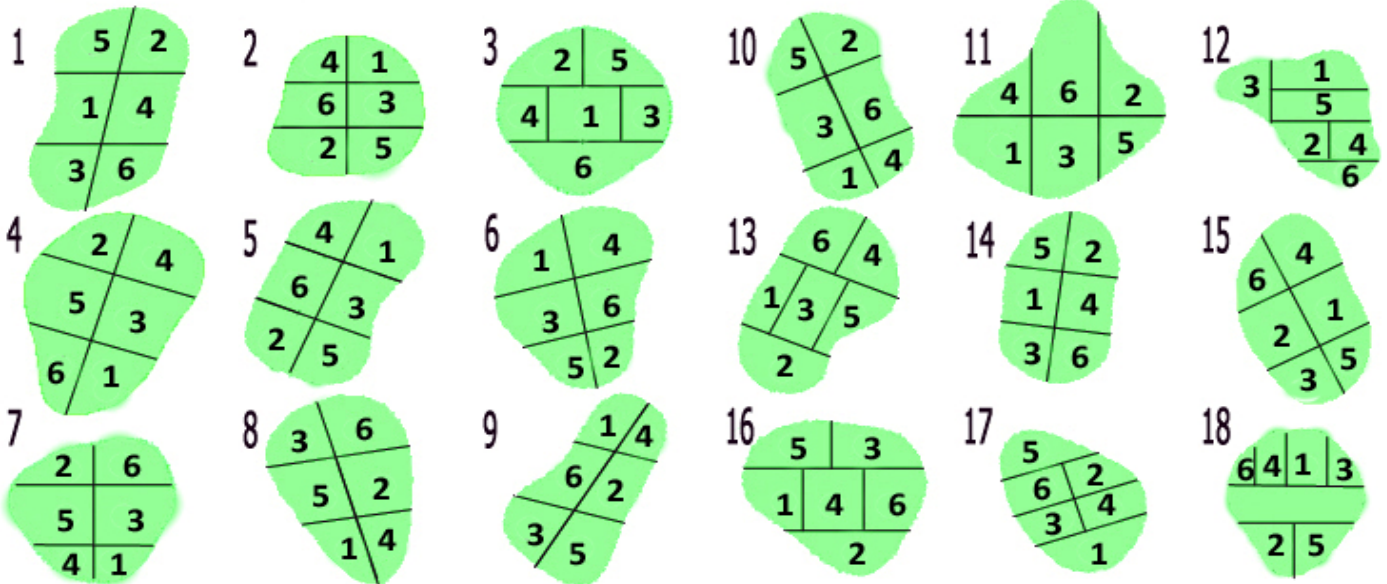

Golf Course Rules

Enter and exit the fairways at the white posts.
Keep the cart between the white posts while you are in the fairway.

No carts are allowed in the rough areas.
Replace all fairway divots with the divot and then use the sand provided to fill in any part of the divot not filled.

Repair all ball marks on the greens.

Anyone operating a cart must be at least 16 years old and have a valid drivers license.

Maintain pace of play with the group in front of you. Enjoy your round of golf at Lake Forest. Questions call 245-6184

Repairing Ball Marks

In an effort to encourage the membership to continue fixing ball marks, we have provided you with some factual information that may interest you. **Unrepaired ball marks take at least two to three weeks to properly heal, leaving behind unsightly, uneven putting surfaces.** On the other hand, a repaired ball mark takes only half the time to heal. Beginner or pro, it is your responsibility as a golfer to fix your own ball marks. If you are truly a steward of the game, you'll fix any others you see while your partners are putting as well.
